[16th to 31st August 2019] Celebration of 'Swachhta Pakhwada'

Various activities were undertaken in the school to the action plan of NCL during 'Swachhta Pakhwada' from 16th August to 31st August 2019.

a. Appointment of 'Cleanliness Monitors

The Principal conducted a meeting with the council members of the school to appoint a team of 'Keep School Clean (Cleanliness Monitors) to brief the members to execute the action plan on the movement.

b. Special Morning Assembly

A special morning assembly was conducted where the Principal administered the oath to the students and staff to keep the surrounding clean. The students, few staff members and the Principal delivered speeches to emphasise the importance of sanitation and good hygiene. The sweepers of the school were honoured for their noble job of maintaining cleanliness in the school.

c. Drawing/ Painting
