#### **[03<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> July 2025] New Recruitment**

#### **[12.7.2025] OPEN DAY**

The first Open Day of the session was held on 12<sup>th</sup> July 25 for classes Balvatika I to XII.

The aim was to strengthen the communication between parents and teachers and discuss the academic progress and overall development of students.
