Students and Staff participated in the International Day of Yoga 2025.

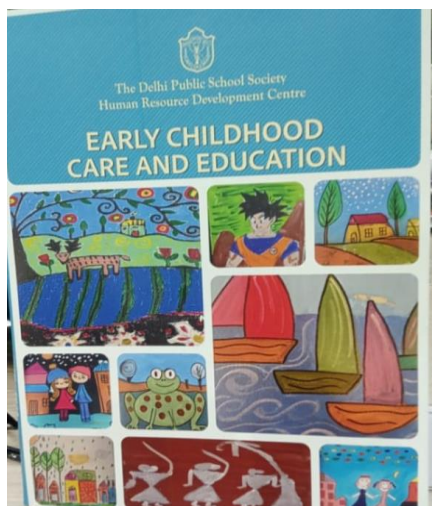
