The following were the main activities/programmes/functions held in our school during the month of October 2018.

ACTIVITIES

[02-10-18] : Gandhi and Shastri Jayanti

Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated in the school with great enthusiasm on 2nd October 2018. It was the 21st year since the inception of the school that this auspicious occasion is being celebrated in the form of '**Sarva Dharma Sabha**' in the presence of students and staff.

The programme coordinators Dr. N.P.Mishra, PRT Sanskrit and Ms. Jasbir Kaur Mann, PGT English, welcomed the staff and students.

The programme started by, the Principal and Headmistress, garlanding the photograph of Mahatma Gandhi and lighting incense sticks.

Students from different classes delivered speeches and recited poems throwing light on the life of Gandhiji. They talked about early life of Gandhiji and his revolutionary movements. Few staff members shared their views on the teachings of Mahatma Gandhi highlighting the 'Relevance of Gandhian philosophy' in the present times.

The celebration also focussed on the oneness of all human beings, by the staff members sharing their views on all the religions, for mankind. Md. Rizwan Ahmad, PGT Economics, shared the teachings of Islam, Ms. Jeevan Joseph, PRT Maths, spoke on Christianity by sharing the teachings of Jesus which also included '**The Sermon on the Mount**', Mr. Ajeet Singh, TGT Hindi spoke on Hinduism and Ms. Jasbir Kaur Mann, PGT English, sang shabads from Gurbani.
