Sub: Report regarding activities/programmes/functions held during the month of September 2020.

The following were the main activities/programmes/functions held in our school during the month of **September 2020**.

05-9-20 [Virtual Celebration of Teacher's Day]

The school celebrated virtual 'Teachers' Day' wherein the Principal along with five staff members hoisted the tricolour. The other staff members were enabled to be virtually a part of the celebration through Zoom App.

As is the custom of the school, the teachers present the morning assembly and then the children present cultural programme to honour the teachers.

The pandemic times could neither dampen the enthusiasm of the teachers nor the students.

A virtual assembly was conducted by the staff members covering all the events and its video was shared with the students through their Whatsapp groups.

The students also took the e-way to express gratitude to their teachers by preparing videos including speeches, poems and thoughts and shared with their teachers.

The individual messages of the Principal, Headmistress and staff members were compiled and the video was shared with the students and also uploaded on the school's website.

07-09-20 [Mind Wars]

The students from classes IV to X enrolled themselves to participate in the All-India G.K. Olympiad available on the Mind Wars platform on the Zee5 app.

08-09-20 to 14-8-20 [Celebration of Reading Week]

In order to inculcate the reading habits among children the 'Reading Week was celebrated', as per the circular of the CBSE, in the schools wherein children from classes I to XII enthusiastically participated in the same.

The activity was taken up virtually by the language teachers during the language classes.

The suggested activities of the CBSE were divided into various groups according to the level of the students.

Classes I to V

- The students drew pictures of their favourite characters from the stories they had read and even dressed up in the same costume and shared with their class-teachers.
- They even shared videos telling stories and reading books.
- Children shared pictures of the puzzles and riddles and comic strips related to the short stories read by them.

Classes VI to VIII

- The teachers encouraged the students to share stories and poems written by them.
- The children presented the reviews of the books read by them.

Classes IX to XII

- An Online Read-a-thon activity was conducted in the class.
- Children were motivated to make Book-Buddies wherein children paired themselves to read a particular book and presented it in front of the class.
- Children shared reviews of the books read by them.
- Sessions on tell round robin stories were conducted wherein the teacher began the story and the students of the class continued with the next part of the story.
- There were class discussions wherein students talked about the books that they read, highlighting their favourite characters.
