Sub: Report regarding activities/programmes/functions held during the month of May & June 2026.

The following were the main activities/programmes/functions held in our school during the month of May and June 2026.

[15.5.26] Basic First Aid Training Programme 2.0 – NCL Nigahi

Northern Coalfields Limited (NCL), Nigahi Area organised a Basic First Aid Training Programme for school children with the objective of equipping them with essential life-saving skills and creating awareness about emergency response. The programme provided practical training on basic first aid techniques, enabling students to respond confidently and effectively in medical emergencies. The interactive sessions encouraged active participation and helped foster a sense of responsibility, preparedness, and community service among the students.

During the training session, the experts shared valuable insights on various aspects of first aid and emergency response. The key topics covered included:

- Importance of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Safety measures to prevent electric shocks
- Techniques to control bleeding
- First aid for breathing difficulties and choking
- Appropriate response in cases of unconsciousness
- Treatment for nosebleeds

- Awareness of emergency helpline numbers
- Fire safety and precautions during fire emergencies
- Rescue and first aid measures in cases of drowning
- Basic first aid to be administered during road accidents

The programme equipped students with essential life-saving skills and enhanced their awareness and preparedness to respond effectively during emergencies.

Addressing the students, the Principal highlighted the importance of acquiring basic first aid skills as an essential life skill and that timely assistance can often save lives.

The CBSE declared the AISSCE 2026 results on 15th May 2026. Shivam Gupta of the Commerce stream emerged as the school topper securing 95.8% marks.

During the staff meeting, the Principal addressed the staff on various academic and administrative matters. The roles and responsibilities of class teachers, along with the conduct of Class Tests (CTs), were discussed in detail. Teachers were instructed to ensure the timely completion of the syllabus and maintain updated records. Emphasis was laid on collecting and maintaining students' demographic details, including category-wise information.

The assessment process was reviewed, highlighting the effective implementation of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) through both formative and summative assessments, moving beyond traditional pen-and-paper tests in accordance with NEP guidelines. The need for maintaining clear and effective communication with students and parents, and adopting positive changes in teaching practices for the overall well-being and holistic development of the students was also emphasized.

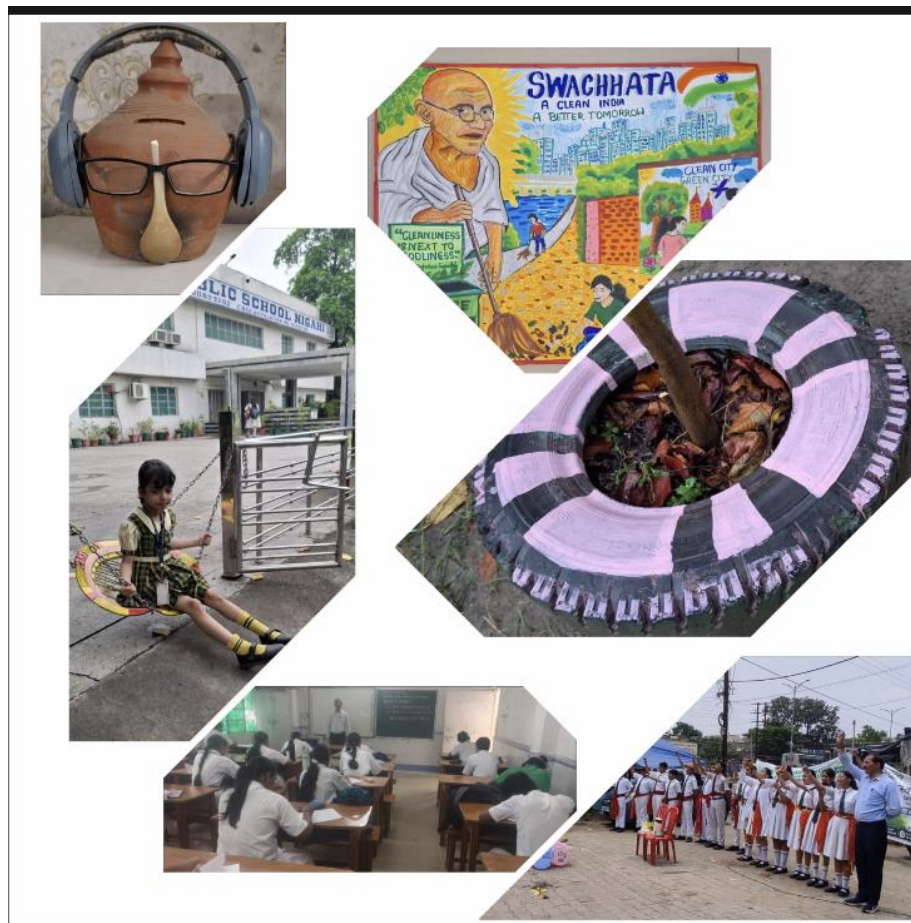
