Sub: Report regarding activities/programmes/functions held during the month of October 2021.

The following were the main activities/programmes/functions held in our school during the month of **October 2021.**

2-10-2021 [Celebration of Gandhi and Shastri Jayanti]

Rich tributes were paid to Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri, on the occasion of their birth anniversaries by the Principal and few staff members, by strictly adhering to Covid-19 guidelines. It was the 24th year since the inception of the school that this auspicious occasion was being celebrated in the form of '**Sarva Dharma Sabha**' in the presence of students and staff.

The Principal and the Headmistress paid floral tributes to the portrait of Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri on this occasion.

The programme coordinators Mr. Manoj Mishra, PGT English, and Dr. Ratnesh Kumar Sinha, PGT Hindi, welcomed the staff and students.

Students from different classes delivered speeches and recited poems throwing light on the life of Gandhiji. They talked about early life of Gandhiji and his revolutionary movements. The school choir along with the music teacher, Mr. Navendu Nath Tiwary, TGT Music, rendered the bhajan '**Vaishnav Jan**' along with the staff and students.

Speaking on the occasion, the Principal emphasized the teachings of Mahatma Gandhi and stressed upon the students to inculcate the message of Gandhi whole heartedly.
